RETORTS

Michael Owen-Smith (1966O) reminded us of a famous rugby game that the recently deceased, Vic Schonborn, scored a winning try in, in 1961. Michael recreates the event.....

"It is worth recording the famous rugby game in 1961, when Vic scored the winning try (and only points of the match) in the top left hand corner at Rondebosch. It was a famous victory as we had 7 or 8 players out injured. After we scored, Rondebosch camped in our 25 (as it was called in those days) and their scrum-half peppered us with up and unders. Duncan Innes (1963G), was called up from the U16 team (he later played on the UCT first XV in addition to being Chairman of the SRC) dealt with everything kicked at him and we defended our line to the end. A notorious victory indeed! Vic was also unbeatable in all the sprint races at the triangular in those days.

Keith Murray (1963F) has fond memories of Vic. Keith writes, "Vic, Dave Armstrong (1962F) and I were the greatest of mates having been in Founders together from 1959 through to 1963. We played rugby, swam and did athletics together (Dave played cricket and left in 1962). We also bunked out to visit our girlfriends who lived in Rondebosch fairly regularly and now they have both passed on which makes one realise how one needs to treasure your friends while you can."

100 YEARS ON.....

Edward Carter (1922G) arrived at Bishops in 1917, after his family had moved from Wepener in the Eastern OFS to Cape Town. Edward's son, David Carter (1958G), came to Bishops in the Centenary year of 1949. David's son, Jonathan (1991F), was a boarder

at Bishops from 1988, and now the Centenarian, Luke Carter entered the Pre-Prep in Grade 1 in 2014 and this year scored the family 100. I have attached a photo of David, Luke and Jonathan along with Luke's Grade 4 class.
